1. Squeeze one end of the toilet paper roll shut and staple or tape.
2. Fill the other end with your goodies. We used stickers and wrapped bubble gum.
3. Staple or tape the other end.
4. Lay your tissue paper flat and put the roll at the bottom in the middle. Now roll it up.
5. When you can't roll anymore, add a piece of tape to the tissue paper so it can't come unrolled.
6. Use the string or tinsel stems to tie each end of the tissue paper.
