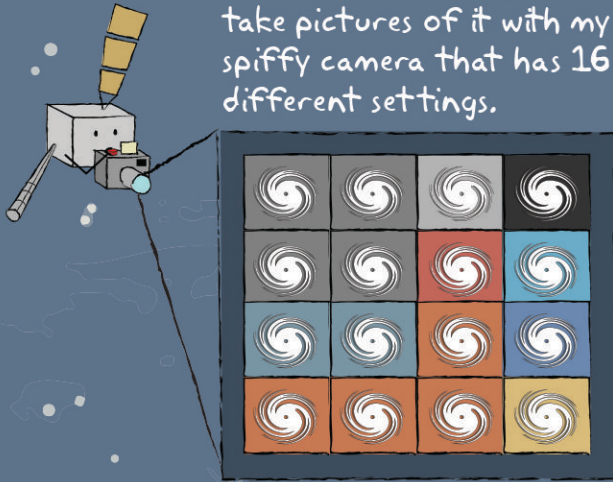
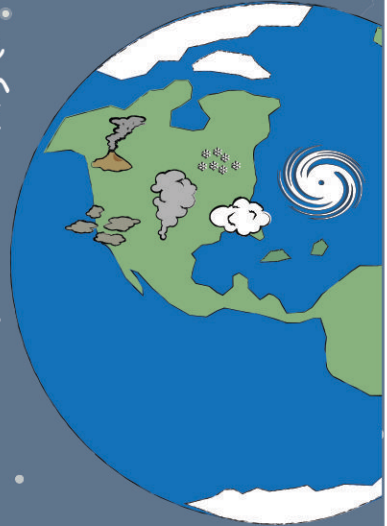


Meet a GOES-R Series Satellite

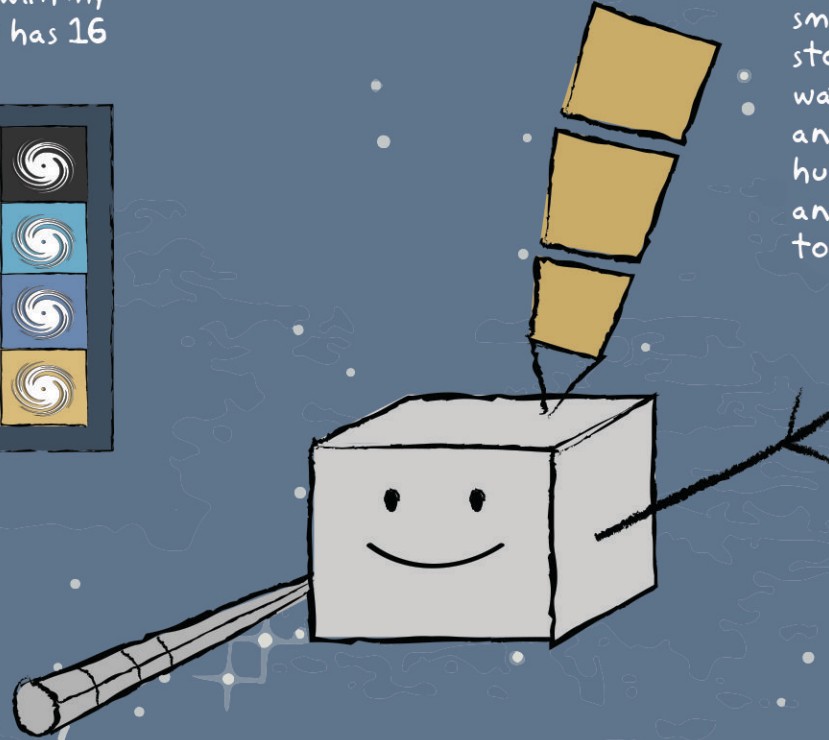
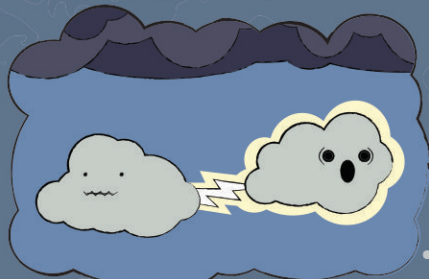
I can see a lot of cool stuff from up here, and I take pictures of it with my spiffy camera that has 16 different settings.
